2) The second step while getting with legal advice and finding a good accountant. (Also finding a good development locale). Is the big money raise. I want to run a rewards based crowdfunding campaign! I imagine the total amount of money we need at a low end to hire on all the people I need to build a working Christian blockchain node network is somewhere in the ballpark of 7 to 10 million.
